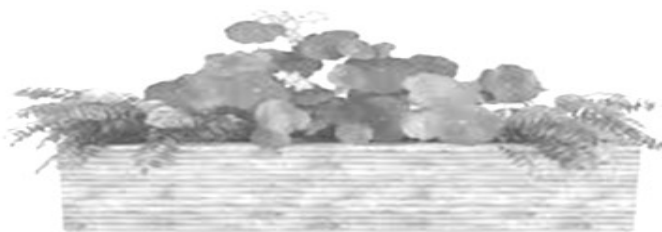

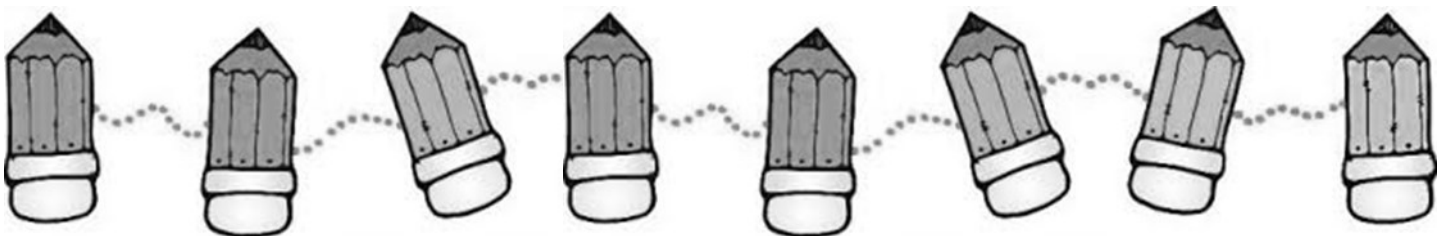
"Wash, wash, wash your hands, play our handy game.

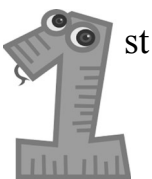

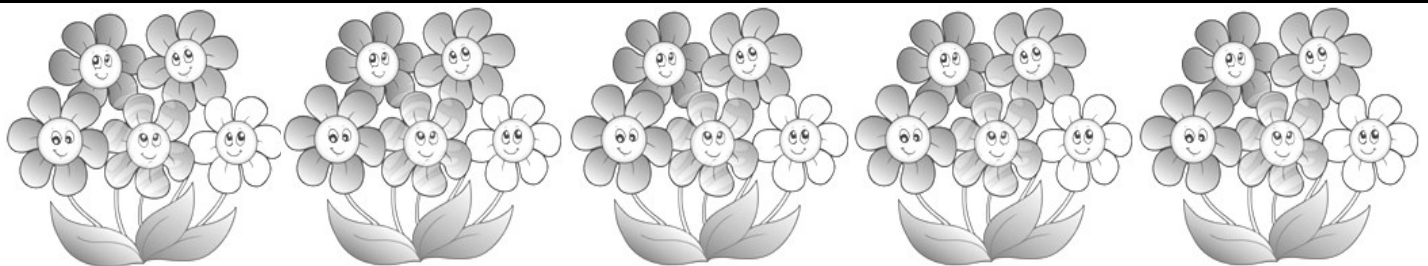

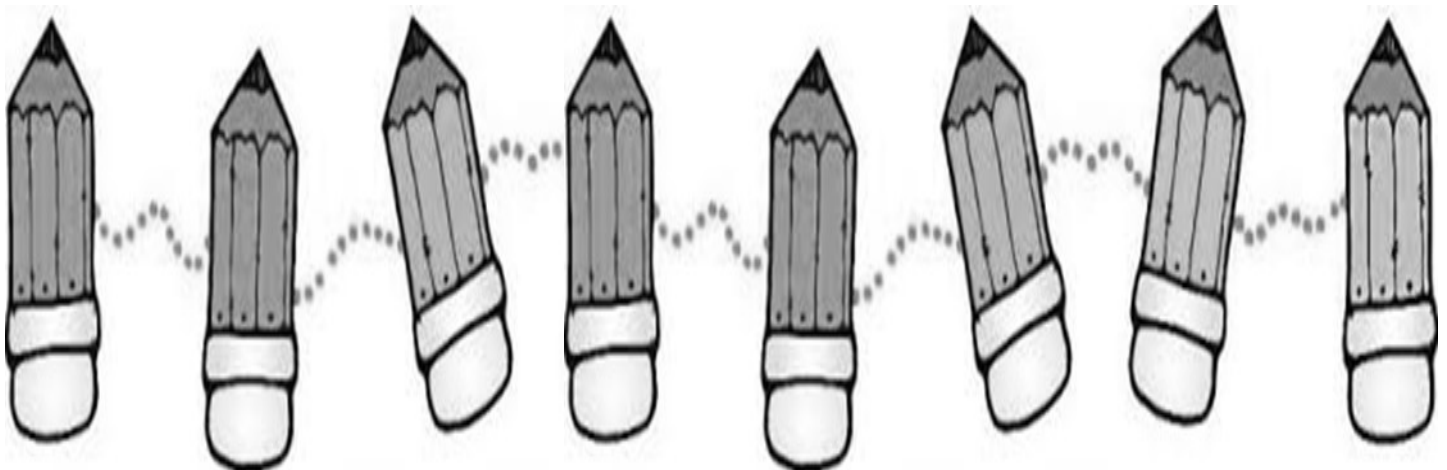


Hello Third Grade Families!

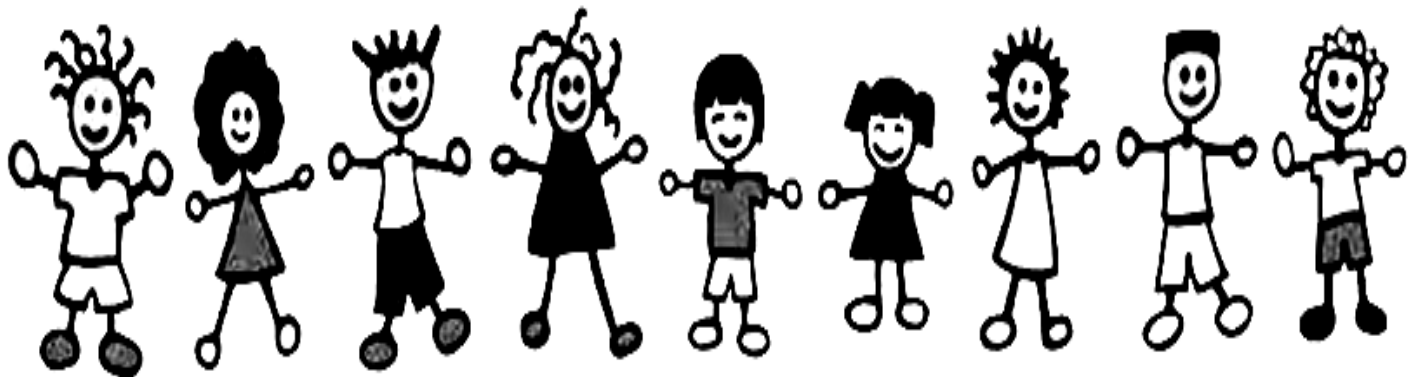

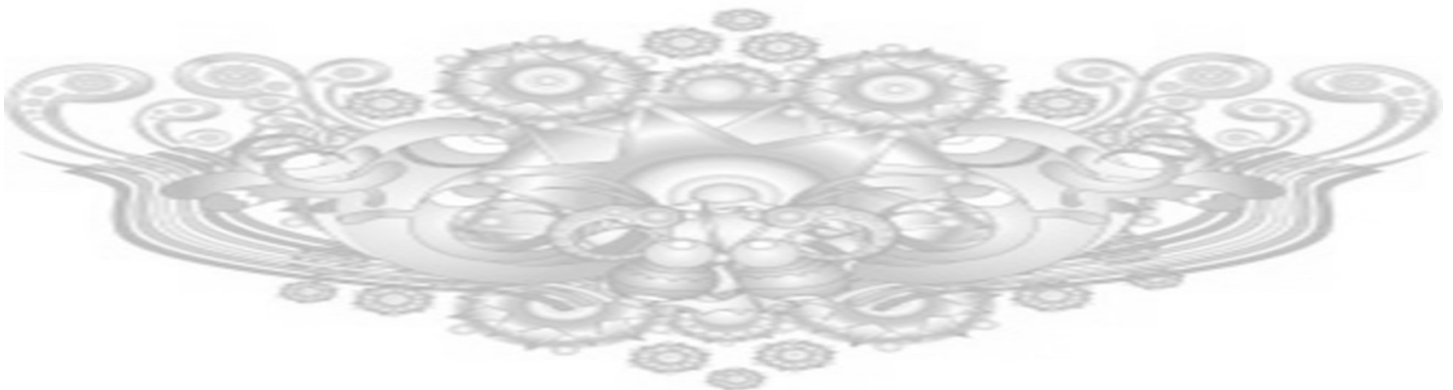

From the Library

Welcome back to a new year at Foster. The mission of the Foster Elementary School library is to support and enhance student achievement and teacher efficacy through providing resources and learning experiences which enhance educational technology, informational literacy and the Jefferson County Public Schools' curriculum and 2020 vision.



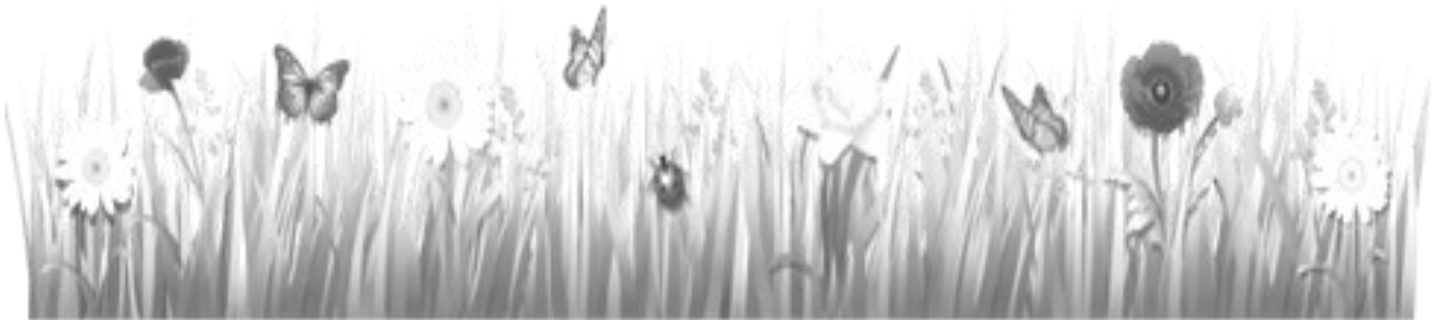
As we begin the year with iPads, we ask families to review iPad Pledge and Mobile Device Use Agreement with your kids to remind them of their responsibility. Though some families make the decision to opt out of iPad use, this only covers home use. All students will have access to iPads for the instructional day and will continue to be responsible for care and proper use of these devices while at school and at home. Technology use and access is a powerful and necessary component of our instructional program and supports students in their acquisition of digital citizenship skills. Questions about opting out can be directed to classroom teachers.

State law requires transparency with families related to what applications and digital tools we are using with students. Teachers will be sharing what apps/tools they are assigning for use in the classroom along with privacy policies of vendors. This information will also be posted soon to our new school website. In addition to those apps teachers are actively using in the classroom, students have access to additional applications on stu-



dent iPads. You can view available apps for your student by clicking the “Self Service” icon on the iPad. Self-service apps have been checked by district personnel for data security and privacy compliance and assigned by grade level. Of course students may also be accessing websites and digital tools not assigned by a teacher; we depend on families to be supporting kids’ appropriate use of all tools while at home. Any tools requiring a student login may be of particular concern.

Equipment issued to students includes an iPad with a 4-piece Otterbox cover, charger and cable. In most cases, students have the same device they had last year. If a component is missing, damaged, or not working, please notify the teacher immediately. The cost of replacement of chargers/cables is dependent upon availability. Currently a charger is \$11.50 and a cable is \$11.50 which families will pay unless the device is new to the student.

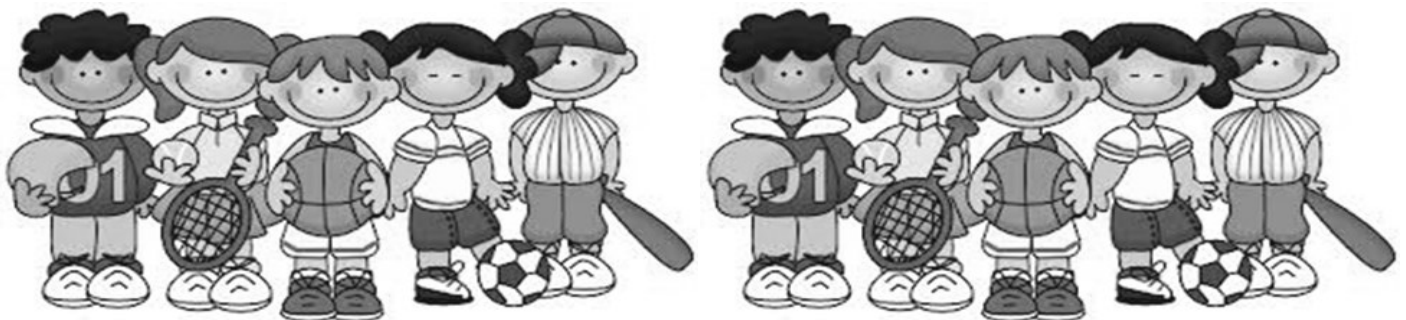
In the month of September, students will focus on fitness concepts, the rules and procedures of PE and collaboration skills that will be applied through out our year.
